The online link will be live on the offficial website of RRC ER from 11.04.2022 onwards and would remain live upto 10.05.2022. The candidates should click on the live link and fill up their Application forms as per instructions of this notification.

## 3. RESERVATION:

- i. candidates, irrespective of community may be considered against **UR** training slots, subject to fulfillment of parameters for UR candidates. No age relaxation is allowed candidates applying against to unreserved training slots whether UR, SC, ST and OBC.
- ii. against the communities However, training slots earmarked for specific i.e. SC. ST and OBC, only candidates will belonging that community be considered.
- iii. Reservation quotas applicable for SC/ST/OBC/EX-SM/EWS/PwBD candidates shall be applicable in accordance with the relevant rules issued bytthe Railway Board.
- iv. In the event of the OBC training slots notified above remaining unfilled, the same will be filled up from the UR candidates. The unfilled SC training slots if it is any shall albebe filled up to ST



candidates, if available and vice/vessa. And diffes what are agreement tiss no otpossible, the evon filled reserved training slots shall be filled up from the UR candidates (Rule 5 off the Apprenticeship Rules, 1992).

- v. The quota training slots im the Ex-SM and PwBD categories are included in the owerall training slots and hence are not to be filled up outside the notified training slots.
- vi. The candidates selected against ESM and PwBD willibe placed drinth the appropriate categories viz. UR/SC/ST/OBC to which they belong to. Unfilled ESM that in images lotts would be filled up from other candidates.
- vii. Reservations to Exserwicemen, their athibbten and athibbten of Akmeed Force personned will be engaged for Apprenticeship as per details mentioned below:

Only locomotor /cerebral palsy (OH), with no serious deformity of the spinal column having not less than 40% disability and Hearing Handicapped (HH) person having 60 decibels or more in the better ear in the conversational range of frequency are eligible to apply. No hearing aid shall be permitted.



#### 4. **ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS**:

#### A. AGE:

- i. The candidates should have completed 155 years of age (as on cutofff date from receiving application). The age as recorded in the Matriculation certificate issued from a government recognized Board/Authority or the Birth Certificate issued from a government recognized authority shall only be reckoned for the purpose. No other document like horoscope, affidavits, birth extract from Municipal Corporation, service records and like will be accepted.
- ii. Upper age limit is relaxable by 05 years in case of SC/ST candidates, 3 years in case of OBC-NCL candidates and 10 years for Persons with Benchmark Disabilities (PWBD) candidates.
- iii. Candidates availing the benefits of the relaxed criteria would be required to produce the relevant documents at the time of document verification for verifying their eligibility for the above-mentioned critteria. Failing to do so will lead to rejection of candidature under relaxed standards.
- Upper age limit is relaxable by additional 10 years for Ex-SM (ex-serviceman) up to the extent of service rendered in Defence Forces plus 03 years provided they have put in a minimum of 06 months service at a stretch, except Exservicemen who on have eathered by joined of the Ex-servicemen status for the purpose of their engagement.
- v. The candidates, without warmt to accusable three toerneefft of necessarily matter of Exservicemen and Armed Forces Personnel, must produce Discharge Certificate and Rensision Papers. Similarly, the children of Ex-servicement amount children of Ammed Forces Personnel must produce Discharge Certificate and Pension Papers OR Serving Certificate of this theorem parents respectively (as the case may be) at the time of document verification.

# **B. EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION:**

- i. The candidate must have passed 10<sup>th</sup> class examination or its equivalent (under 10+2 examination system) with minimum 50% marks, in aggregate, from recognized Board and also should possess the National Trade Certificate in the notified trade issued by NCVT/SCVT.
- ii. However, for **the following** Tradess three miniminum exhlucations and compactification is set that same pass from recognized School and the National Trade Certificate in the notified trade issued by NCVT/SCVT:
  - 1. Welder (Gas and Electric),
  - 2. Sheet Metal Worker,
  - 3. Lineman
  - 4. Wireman
  - 5. Carpenter
  - 6. Painter (General)



# C. MEDICAL FITNESS:

- i. A person shall be eligible for being trained under the Apprentices Act, 1961 and the Apprenticeship Rules, 1992, as amended from time to time, if he or she satisfies the minimum standards of physical fitness as prescribed in the afforesaid act and rules.
- ii. In accordance with Railway Board letter No. E(MPP)/2009/6/14, candidates have to bring a medical certificate at the time of document verification in a prescribed format as per Apprentice Act, 1961 and para 4 of Apprenticeship rules, 1992(as amended from time to time).
- iii. The medical certificate should be signed by Government authorized doctor (Gaz.), not below the rank of Asst. Surgeon of Central/State Hospital. The foforestational control of the website of Railway Recruitment Cell, Eastern Railway www.rrcer.com.

#### 5. MODE OF SELECTION:

- i. Selection of a candidate for training slot obfaunition Eastern Rationary will be on the basis of merit prepared in respect of all eligible candidates, who apply against the notification. Merit list (trade/unit/community wise) will be prepared on the basis of data/details filled up by candidates in the online application form. If any candidate fills up the wrong details then his/her candidature will be cancelled as soon as the discrepancy comes in the notice of Railway administration.
- ii. The Select list for Document Verification (DV) will librecompt the classiss of favore aggree of farks in the Matriculation and ITI. The formula aggiven between the community wise. So ii will be followed for determining the merit. Merit list will be prepared trade/unit/community wise. Candidate must note that no centralized inneriit list will be frommed.
- iii. For the trades for which class 10 th pass is the minimum qualification, a separate merit list will be drawn for edigible candidates taking the average of the percentage marks obtained by the candidates in both matriculation (with minimum 50% (aggregate) marks) and ITI examination giving equal weightage to both. For example AA candidate secured 8505588 marks in Matriculation examination and 91.68% marks in ITI, then marks considered for selection will be ½ [80.58 + 91.68] = 86.13.
  - NOTE:- In case of two candidates having the same marks, the candidate having older age shall be preferred. In case the dates of birth are also magnitude than diabatic later ow paspeds the the matriculation examination earlier shall be considered first.
- iv. For the trades for which class 8 the pass is the minimum qualification, the merit list would be prepared for all eligible candidates, including those having qualification of matriculation and who opt for these trades, based on the average marks obtained both in class 8 th standard and ITI examination, giving equal weightage to both. For example A candidate secured 80.58 marks in 8th class examination and 91.68%/marksinilTT,I,thenmarkscoosisleeddfor selection will be ½ [80.58 + 91.68] = 86.13.



NOTE:- In case of two candidates having the same marks, the candidate having older age shall be preferred. In case the dates of birth are also same, the candidate who passed the 8 class examination earlier shall be considered first.

- v. Candidates to the extent of 1.5 times the notified training slots intherespective communities, as per merit prepared in view of above formula, will be called for Document Verification (DV) of unit, to cater to absenteeism and rejection etc.
- vi. However, the opportunity for training will be given to candidates who are selected as per merit order of their respective community, in the ratio of 1:1 of mottffeed that ining saluts, subject adhering to other prescribed criteria ass poer railway rules, for example medical fitness in required category and rules for verification of a candidate etc.
- vii. A candidate will get selected for training in ONLY one until of Eastern Railway as per procedures mentioned addrove; based on the comparative community wise merit position of candidate and as per available training slots in his/her trade.
- viii. In case of any dispute, the decision taken by railway admaidiret matiko at ivoid foreafinal.

#### 6. <u>APPLICATION FEES:</u>

- i. Application fees (non-**refundable**) is Rs.100/- ((Rupees One hundred)) only. No fee, however, is to be paid by the SC/ST/PWBD/Women candidates).
- ii. The pasyment offfees will the matthew diffeeth though the pasyment can be online Application Form while filling up the continue Application Form. The pasyment can be made by using Debit Card / Credit Card / Internet Banking etc. Transaction charges for online payment, if any, will be borne by the candidate. At times, there may be server issues because of thuge rusth, which many afaffect the online payment system. Such us be sacioarthe then did at each of the card to login fresh and attempt again.
- iii. During submission of online application, a registration number will be issued to each applicant; candidates are advised to reserve/ note their Registration No.

### 7. HOW TO APPLY:

i. Before applying, the candidates should ensure that he/she fulfils all the eligibility criteria. If at any later stage, the particulars furnished by the candidate are revealed to be not conforming with the eligibility criteria, his engagement will be terminated forthwith. All annexures in the given formats for claiming fees exemption, reservation, age relaxation, etc. must be submitted at the time of verification of documents.



- ii. The candidates are required to apply ONLINE by visiting the link provided on the Notice Board of official website of RRC/ER Kolkata www.ceeecooron They must go through the detailed instructions before filling up the online applications.
- iii. All relevant fields/boxes must be carefully filled up by the candidate. The particulars (including spellings) must match with the details available imthe Whaticulation contificate like name, father's name, date of birth etc.
- iv. The candidates should fill the relevant columns regarding their community as per the government issued certificates for SC/ST/OBC/EWS armod polynyssical dissabbility...
- v. Candidates can **apply for any** unit off **Eastternn Railway ffor thaining ass Actt Apprentice** Thainese as per notified training slots of units of Eastern Railway thtorough this is or tification. However, they would **have to exercise** options for giving preference to **units** ffor training.
- vi. However, a camdidate will get selected for training in CONLLY/one-cunitibé Hastern Radikay as per procedures mentioned in Para 5 of this notification, based on the comparative community wise merit position of candidate and as per available training stats im this treent tradte.
- vii. The candidates are advised to indicate their mobile numbers and valid e-mail IDs which need to be kept active over the entire process of selection, since communication for further selection process will be made through these media. No letter will be sent by post from RRC ER.

#### viii. <u>Documents to be uploaded:</u>

- a. Scanned Photograph Camdidates are required to uplload their good quality and contrast colour photograph, not more than 3 months old, at the space provided in the online Application Form. The scanned photo should be in the JPG/JPEG format and within the specified file size assmeatitioned in the Application Form. The photograph should be clear, without cap or sunglasses and should have defined edges. The candidates should also keep 10 compiles off the scanne photograph for future purposes.
- b. <u>Scanned signature</u> Candidates are required too upploated their foll signature at the space provided in the online Application Form, which has to be in JPG/JPEG format and within the specified file size as mentioned in the Application Form. The application submitted without signature will be summarily rejected.
- c. <u>Standard 8th and 10th mark sheet</u> pdf format with specified file size as mentioned in the application form.
- d. <u>ITI Certificate from NCVT/SCVT</u> pdf format with specified file size as mentioned in the application form.



- e. <u>Community certificate for SC/ST/OBC/EWS</u> pdf format with specified file size as mentioned in the application form.
- f. PwBD Certificate, in pdf as applicable with specified file size as mentioned in the application form.

NOTE:- The format of the Community certifficates, EWS certifficate and PWBD certifficate shall be as per the document uploaded in the website.

- ix. All other relevant columns of the Application Form should be filled up by the candidates.
- x. After final submission of online application, no candidates willibbeation and correction/alteration online.
- xi. The Railway Recruitment Cell (RRC)/Eastern Railway resesses the right to reject the incomplete applications.
- xii. Candidates are advised to take a print out of the filled-uponline Application Formafter all details have been filled and the Form has been confirmed to have been submitted.
- xiii. <u>HELP DESK</u> For any problems in submitting the applications online or printing of the application, candidates can seek help through Helpline process and notified on website of RRC ER.

# 8. <u>INVALID APPLICATIONS:</u>

The applications having any one of the following deficiencies/discrepancies or irregularities will be summarily rejected:

- a. Signature in **Block/Capital Letter**.
- b. Left Thumb Impression/ Signature not affixed on the application and at prescribed place.
- c. Smudged/Blurred LTI
- d. Caste certificate and other certificates not uploaded and not obtained from appropriate authority.
- e. Non-payment of prescribed fee (where applicable).
- f. Not having requisite educational and/ technical qualification as notified.
- g. More than one application by single candidate.
- h. Applications send by any other mode than the online mode.
- i. Any other irregularities which are considered invalid by FREC.
